Roger Babik is the President of MP. Roger began working at Cincinnati Bell after graduation from Milligan College in 1979.

He founded MP in 1994 to provide clothing, jobs, and the Gospel in Ukraine. Roger was ordained as a pastor in May 1996 after leaving CBT. He works closely with MP staff, volunteers and board members to provide overall leadership, strategic planning and development efforts.
