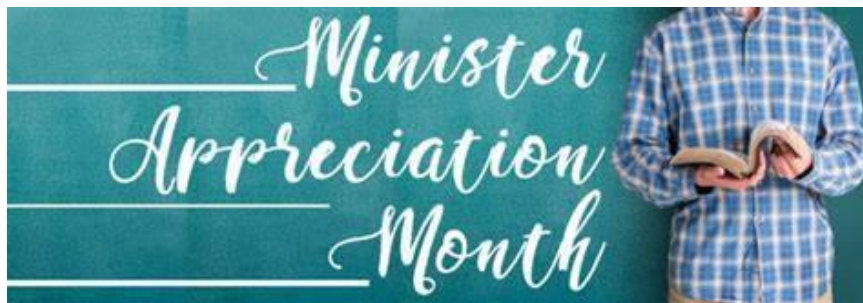

## Adopt a College Student Ministry

Oftentimes when students go to college, they can feel lonely, overwhelmed, homesick and even tempted to participate in worldly behavior, especially those who are not secure in their faith.

The Adopt a College Student Ministry is a wonderful way to help a college student feel loved and encouraged, all while talking to them about Jesus and praying for them.

The students participating are either students from GCCC, or friends they have made in college. Some of these friends are not yet grounded in their faith and need extra love and support. You could be the first connection they have to Jesus!!

### How it Works

- You will choose one student (or more if wanted) and adopt them for 2 semesters - 1 calendar year.
- You will send them at least one card a month, and a few care packages, especially around Christmas and their birthday. Care packages can contain simple items e.g., granola bars, popcorn, or dollar store items - doesn't have to be expensive.

**Above all you will pray for them!**

- You will be given info about your students i.e., name, age, major, what kind of food they like, and their hobbies as well as any allergies.
