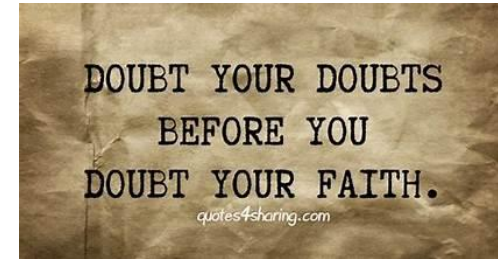

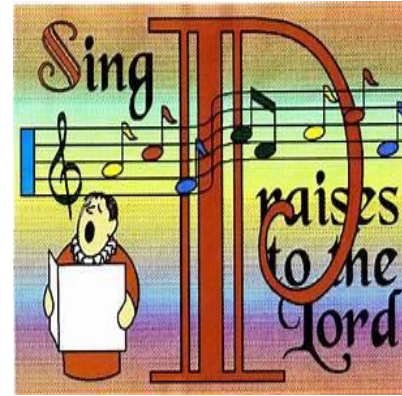

Tornado Awareness April and May

Should there be a tornado warning, what should we do? The term "Shelter in Place" has been around for a while. Our Shelter in Place is the Fellowship Hall in the basement area where we can stay safe during any emergency. Your Safety Team members will alert the congregation if a tornado warning goes into effect while we are gathered here at church. The Shelter in Place has food & water.

During a tornado warning (which means a tornado has been sighted in our area) we should exit the main floor and go to the basement area using either the stairwell behind the stage in the sanctuary, the stairwell in the main entry area or the stairwell at the front of the church near the front entrance and meet in the Fellowship Hall.

Those needing assistance to move to safety will be assisted by our safety team or family members.

Please remember to not leave the property. The safest place will be in the basement area; our Shelter in Place here at church, until the warning is lifted. In addition, your family members will not wonder where you are, they will know.
