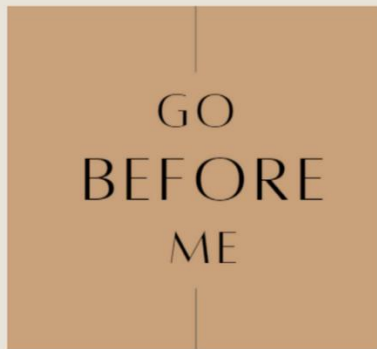
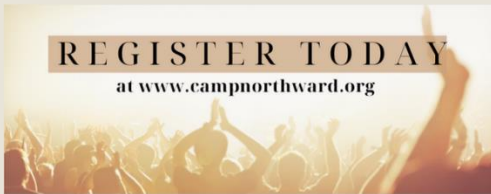
WORSHIP
