- As a ministry to preschoolers and their families.
- There is no private preschool (to our knowledge) in Pendleton County.
- 61% of Pendleton Co. Kindergarteners are currently deemed “not ready” for Kindergarten.
- PC is ranked 121 out of 170 counties for kindergarten readiness.

This Will NOT...

- Replace Tuesday School.
- Be a daycare center.

This WILL...

- Be a tuition based program.
- Be 3 hours a day, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Be for 4-year-olds the year before Kindergarten.
- Provide a Christ-centered and Bible-based preschool education that encourages a child's growth spiritually, academically, socially, verbally and physically.
