It is seen in the first slain animal (Genesis 3:21), in the ram provided in Isaac's place (Genesis 22:13), on the doorposts in Egypt (Exodus 12:7), when John the Baptist said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29), and on the Roman cross when Jesus said "It is finished" (John 19:30).
